What You Can Expect

This training of chainsaw safety will have both classroom and outdoor sessions where participants will be able to test techniques taught by the instructor.

Participants will learn about personal protective equipment, chainsaw safety features, and basic maintenance techniques to achieve maximum chainsaw performance such as proper filing techniques.

In addition, participants will learn about open face gelling, including pre-planning the fell and target accuracy, bore cutting, chainsaw reactive forces as well as understanding hinge strength.

Instructor Lee Schauman has been in the logging business for most of his life. Lee helped his Uncle cut Balsam, and earned money for college by cutting wood during the summer months. He has 15+ years of safety training.

Instructor Jim Olive, has 10+ years of experience. Jim grew up with a father that was in the logging industry. Like many Jim can share bad experiences using a chainsaw. These experiences have added to Jim's knowledge and passion for chainsaw safety.
