Learn how the **TRANSITIONAL JOBS (TJ) PROGRAM** can benefit you

What is the Transitional Jobs (TJ) Program? The TJ Program helps individuals transition into stable employment while helping employers find needed talent in exchange for the simple investment of providing training and mentoring. UMOS operates the program, which serves Menominee, Langlade, Forest and Florence Counties, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families.

How Can Employers Benefit from the TJ Program? The program helps you find good workers to fill jobs at no cost to you. Your recruitment and hiring cost are significantly reduced or eliminated. UMOS will pay wages (at \$7.25/hour) for up to six months as well as payroll taxes and workers compensation insurance. The program allows you to “try out” job candidates, and you have the choice to interview and select the right worker(s) before you hire.
