The Entrepreneurial Training Program (ETP) offered by the Small Business Development Center (SBDC) at UW-Stevens Point is a nine-week course that provides an easy to follow, step by step process to write your business plan!

Class Fee: \$250 (The Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation is offering qualified applicants Entrepreneurial Training Grants that cover most of the \$1,000 course fee. If a qualified plan is turned in within 90 days of completion of the course, the grant covers 75 percent of the tuition, reducing your cost to \$250.) An additional, \$200 scholarships are available for Langlade County Residents that successfully complete the course. This reimbursement is made possible by the Suick Family Foundation.
