

Top Request: Recreation Map





- Rec Map Distributed: The 2025 Langlade County Recreation Maps were received on November 19, 2024. 2,054 of the 2025 Langlade County Recreation Maps have been distributed from the Economic Development Corporation Office since November 19, 2024.
- Facebook: 15,758 "Followers" The top post in April post the ATV/UTV Trail System opening on May 1st. This post reached 29,273 people with 231 interactions of which 118 were shares. Of the 46,477 views, 85% were from non-followers.
 - The 19-day paid social media post was targeting the NFL Draft attendees to come to Langlade County and Green Bay residents to escape the Draft congestion. Langlade County is an easy 1.5-hour drive that still has rooms available. The promotion reached 22,069 people with 66,024 views, 366 landing page views, 445 post engagements, and 397 link clicks.
